Basic Digital Photography

Learn how to use all the features on your digital camera! This class will provide a basic understanding of exposure, composition, studio, post-processing and critique. Each student will prepare and exhibit a digital portfolio at the end of the class. Students must provide a digital or 35mm film SLR with manual controls, preferably with a flash. Additional materials each student must provide include a notebook, memory cards and batteries for taking several hundred photos. Class limit 10.
