



## Under 18 Title IX Training Information

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Good Morning,

We are so excited to have you as part of our campus community this year!

Emmanuel College, in compliance with federal law under Title IX, requires that each of our students complete an online training course regarding sexual misconduct. This is required for all new AND returning students. You may have already received training in a similar capacity in high school. The course will take approximately 45 minutes to complete and you must listen to **all audio and view all slides** in order for your training to be counted. In addition, you must score at least a **70% on the assessment** at the end. Your completion will be tracked for compliance purposes and you must complete the training prior to arriving on campus. If you will be a resident student, you will not be permitted to move into the residence halls until the training has been completed, so please be sure to complete it within the next couple of weeks. You must use your first and last name and **EC email address (or another personal email address if you have not yet been assigned an EC address)** to login using the link below. Otherwise, your completion won't be tracked properly. You may start and stop the course as long as you use your same login information, click the "remember me" box on the login page, and do not close the browser that you were originally using or your data will be lost. We recommend that you complete the training in one sitting. You can keep track of your progress by clicking the red circle at the top of the training page. Please print or screenshot your certificate of completion which can be found in the "More" section of the module. You will also receive an email with your certificate from the address '**noreplies@brainshark.com**' so be sure to check your "Clutter or Junk e-mail" box just in case it goes there. Please keep track of the certificate in case it is ever needed.

Since you are under the age of 18, and are considered a minor, we recommend that you view the course with your parents present. While the video is geared for those over the age of 18 and discusses a variety of reporting/confidentiality options afforded to students under Emmanuel College's Title IX policy, please note that as a minor if you were to find yourself a victim of sexual harassment or assault, we would have to contact the authorities immediately. Once you turn 18, however, there are more reporting/confidentiality options that may be available to you, depending on the type of complaint that is filed.
